Conflict of Interest – The Bright Line Rule

Arnice was appointed as the Chief Executive Officer (Operations) of Scarlett Airlines in June 2007 and had since been working in that position. Five years ago, she ran into her ex-boyfriend from college, Mark, who informed her that he is now a licensed solicitor. The duo continued their friendship and Arnice consulted Mark on various legal issues relating to her personal life.

Three years ago, Arnice spoke to the board of Scarlett Airlines about retaining Mark as an external solicitor for her department. This was approved, and Arnice had conveyed this news to Mark, jokingly telling him that she was now his boss and Mark must obey all her instructions or she would not hesitate to fire him. Both parties have continued working harmoniously, with Arnice supplying the bulk of Scarlett's instructions to Mark, who also continued to work on Arnice's personal legal matters.
